ORDINANCE PARTIALLY LIFTING THE LIQUOR BAN WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF NARVACAN, ILOCOS SUR DURING THE MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (MGCQ), AMENDING SECTION 10C OF ORDINANCE NO. 24, SERIES OF 2020 ENTITLED ENACTING THE NARVACAN ANTI-COVID-19 (NOVEL CORONA VIRUS) ORDINANCE, CONSOLIDATING ALL ANTI-CORONA ORDINANCES, MEASURES AND ISSUANCES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Proclamation No. 929 which imposed an Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) throughout Luzon due to the Covid-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2020, the Sangguniang Bayan of Narvacan passed and approved Ordinance No. 24, Series of 2020 Enacting the Narvacan Anti-Covid 19 (Novel Corona Virus) Ordinances, Measures and Issuances, and for Other Purposes which temporarily prohibited the sale, transfer, providing, giving, serving, drinking and the like, of any liquor or intoxicating drink or concoction in the municipality;

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the aforementioned Ordinance is to curtail and eliminate the Covid-19 threat by imposing, among others, social distancing measures and prohibit unnecessary congregation of persons to lessen the risk of transmitting Covid-19;

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2020, Ilocos Sur was placed under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ), the transition phase between General Community Quarantine (GCQ) and New Normal, when the following temporary measures are relaxed and become less necessary: limiting movement and transportation, the regulation of operating industries, and the presence of uniformed personnel to enforce community quarantine protocols. Under MGCQ, among other provisions, offices, establishments, or individuals conducting or providing activities or services in industries classified as beverages, including alcoholic drinks, are allowed to operate at 50% operational capacity;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that:

SECTION 1. SECTION 10C OF ORDINANCE NO. 24, SERIES OF 2020 ENTITLED ENACTING THE NARVACAN ANTI-COVID-19 (NOVEL CORONA VIRUS) ORDINANCE, CONSOLIDATING ALL ANTI-CORONA ORDINANCES, MEASURES AND ISSUANCES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES shall be partially amended as follows: **PARTIAL LIFTING OF THE LIQUOR BAN.** The suspension of liquor ban temporarily imposed during the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) is hereby partially lifted during the Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) beginning June 1, 2020.

SECTION 2. CONDITIONS/RESTRICTIONS.

- a) Selling of liquor or other intoxicating beverages by licensed retailers, suppliers and wholesalers strictly for the private consumption of customers shall be allowed during regular market operating hours. No selling of the same shall be done during the curfew hours from 8:00 in the evening to 5:00 in the following morning.
- b) Consumption of liquor or intoxicating drinks is allowed as long as it is done inside private residences. Drinking outside the premises of the house and public places shall not be allowed at all times.
- c) Social drinking shall be strictly prohibited. Provided, that group drinking inside residences shall be limited to a maximum of three (3) persons, and strict social distancing and other precautionary measures, including the avoidance of the customary one shot glass shall be observed at all times.
- d) Restaurants, bars, canteens, carinderias and other dine-in establishments are prohibited to serve liquor or intoxicating drinks in their establishments.

SECTION 3. SANCTIONS. Any person, entity, or establishment found to be in violation of this Ordinance shall be meted sanctions:

First Offense	-	A fine of Php 1,500.00
Second Offense	-	A fine of Php 2,000.00
Third Offense	-	A fine of Php 2,500.00, and another fine of Php 2,500.00 for every succeeding offense

SECTION 4. ENFORCEMENT AND REGULATION. The Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO), the Barangays and the Narvacan Police shall enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provision hereof which are not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules or regulations in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. Upon urgent certification of the Mayor and motion unanimously approved suspending the rule on the 3-day reading of Ordinances, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon approval.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
