#### ARTICLE III

## NAME OF EMPLOYER AND PLACE OF OPERATION

SECTION 1 The definite employer is the Senior Citizens Center of the DSWD Municipal Office of Narvacan.

The place of operation is at Barangay Bantay Abot, Narvacan, Ilocos Sur.

# ARTICLE IV MEMBERSHIP

- COMPOSITION
  The governing body of BBASCO shall be composed of the EXECUTIVE BOARD which shall consist of the following: President, Vice President, Secretary, Asst. Secretary, Treasurer, Asst. Treasurer, Auditor, Asst. Auditor, PRO, Asst. PRO, Business Manager, Asst. Business Manager, Board Members and Advisers. Only citizen and permanent resident of the barangay who reach the age sixty (60) years old shall become members.
- SECTION 2 VOTING RIGHTS:
  All members can exercise his/her right to vote during regular and special meetings.
- SECTION 3 All elected officials of the organization shall upon assumption to office, take an oath of office or affirmation in the prescribe form duly subscribed before a person authorized to administer oath.

Copies of the oath or affirmation shall be file and preserved in the office of the DSWD of Narvacan, Ilocos Sur.

SECTION 4 TERMINATION OF MEMBERS:
Any members is terminated if he/she travels abroad
without permission, voluntarily resigns and in case of
death.

#### ARTICLE V

FEES, DUES, FINES AND OTHER PAYMENTS

- ECTION 1 There shall be a monthly contribution of Five Pesos (P5.00) and membership fee of Fifty Pesos (P50.00).
- SECTION 2 All amounts collected shall constitute of the General Fund of BBASCO to be applied to the operational and organizational expenses of the organization as may be authorized by the Executive Board.
- SECTION 3 Special or other extraordinary fees shall be made only upon majorily vote during general meeting.
- All payments of fees and other contributions by a member shall be evidenced by a receipt of recorded in the log-book signed by the treasurer and entered into the records of the organization to be kept and maintain for the purpose.

SECTION 5 Every expenditures of funds of the BBASCO shall be evidenced by a receipt from the person to show the payment is made which shall state the date, place and purpose of such payment.

Such receipt shall form part of the financial record of the organization.

SECTION 6. The book of accounts and other records of the financial activities of the organization shall be open for inspection by any officer or member anytime during office hours.

# ARTICLE VI OFFICERS

- SECTION 1 The governing body of BBASCO shall be Executive Board composed of the duly elected and appointed officers.
- SECTION 2 The Executive Board shall administer the BBASCO affairs, formulate policies, and implement programs to effectively carryout objectives of the organization, and manage all the monies and properties of the organization.
- SECTION 3 The Executive Board shall consist of the following:
  - President
  - Vice President
  - Secretary
  - Asst. Secretary
  - Treasurer
  - Asst. Treasurer
  - Auditor
  - Asst. Auditor
  - PRO
  - Asst. PRO
  - Business Manager
  - Asst. Business Manager
  - Board Members
  - Advisers
- SECTION 4 The officers of BBASCO shall hold, for a period of three (3) years from the date of their election until their successor shall have been elected or qualified.
- Vacancies in the Executive positions shall be filled up by the Board by appointing any member in good standing of the organization. The said appointee shall hold office in acting capacity for the unexpired term of office of the immediate predecess or or until special election therefore as authorized by the governing body.

# ARTICLE VII DUTIES AND POWERS

- SECTION 1 The President shall be the Executive Officer of BBASCO.
  His powers and duties shall include the following:
  - A.) Preside over all meetings and deliberations of the Executive B oard and of the general membership;
  - B.) Appoint all members of the standing committee of BBASCO with the concurrence of the majority of the Executive Board;
  - C.) Exercise general supervision over all the activities of the association;

- D.) Call special meeting of the organization or Executive Board whenever he/she deems necessary;
- E.) Sign, indorse and deliver all checksm draft bills of exchange, promissory notes: and order of payments in the name and in behalf of the organization together with the treasurer;
- F.) Serve as official spokesman of BBASCO.
- SECTION 2 The Vice President shall perform the duties and functions of the President in case of the latter's absence, disability, death or resignation. He/She shall perform functions that may be assigned to her/him by the President.

Coordinate with the President regarding all matters of the association.

Assist in maintaining peace and order during meeting and other affairs of BBASCO for security purposes.

Perform such duties as determined by the Board.

- SECTION 3 The Secretary shall perform the following:
  - A.) Keep complete records and minutes of all meetings of Executive Board and the general membership;
  - B.) Keep book of minutes of the resolution and a contirating registration of all members of BBASCO.
  - C.) Prepare and give all motices required by law or Constitution of BBASCO as well as notices of all meetings;
  - D.) Takk down minutes of all meetings of the general membership and of the Executive Board;
  - E.) Perform such other duties as maybe prescribed by the Board or by the President.
- SECTION 4 The Treasurer shall:
  - A.) Be the custodian of all funds and properties of BBASCO
  - B.) Sign and pay all vouchers covering obligations legally incurred and authorized;
  - C.) Collect and Reep an accurate up-to-date records of books of all receipts and expenditures which shall be opened for inspection to any member during office hours only:
  - D.) Perform such other related functions as may be prescribed by the Board.
- SECTION 5 The Auditor shall see to it that all accounts and books of BBASCO are properly kept and shall make full detailed and periodic audit of all funds and the accounts of the organization and shall certify this to the President in a report which shall be in writing.
- SECTION 6 The Press Relation Officer shall take charge of all business affairs of BBEECO.

# DUTIES AND RIGHTS OF THE MEMBERS

#### SECTION 1 Duties of Members

- A.) Pay the membership fee and other contributions maybe determined by the general membership on the recommendation of the Executive Board;
- B.) Attend regularly in every meeting as maybe called by the President or the Executive Board;
- C.) Participate and cooperate in the dissemination of government programs for the benefit and progress of the organization as well as the community as a whole;
- D.) Promote the aim and objectives of BBASCO for the success and welfare of co-members;
- E.) Chey the rules and regulations provided for this By-Laws and the decision and policies of the Executive Board.
- SECTION 2 Right of the Members: Every member in good standing shall have the following rights:
  - A.) All members can exercise his right to vote during regular or special meetings;
  - B.) To vote on all matters brought during meetings;
  - C.) Participate in the deliberation during membership meetings;
  - D.) Seek any elective position;
  - E.) Inspect and examine the book's of accounts and other records of BBASCO.

#### ARTICLE IX

#### MEETINGS OF THE MEMBERS

SECTION 1 Place and Date: The regular meeting of the organization is once a month which shall be on the second Sunday of the month at the Barangay Hall unless written notice of such meeting should fix another place and date.

The meeting shall start at 1:00 in the afternoon.

- SECTION 2 Notice: Written notice of the meeting shall be send to each officer at least two (2) days prior to the date of such meeting.
- SECTION 3 Special Meeting: Special meeting of the organization may be called by the President at his discretion. A written notice of the meeting stating the day, time and place and the purpose shall be served to every officer before the date of such special meeting.
- SECTION 4 Proxy: Voting by proxy is not allowed.

- SECTION 5 Quorum: Except when a greater proportion is required herein or by law, a majority vote shall prevail at meeting
  and deliberations. A majority of the members of the organization shall constitute a quorum to officially transact
  a business.
- SECTION 6 Minutes of the Meeting: Minutes of all meetings shall be kept and carefully preserved as a record of the business transaction. The minutes shall contain such entries as may be required by law.
- SECTION 7 Absences: Any officer or member who absent himself from a meeting shall be fined unless he/she is sick in the amount of Fifty Pesos (P50.00).

# ARTICLE X

#### AMEN DMENTS

- SECTION 1 Proposals for amendments to this Constitution may be made by the Executive Board.
- SECTION 2 No proposal shall be considered an amendments and become a part of this Constitution until after the same shall be ratified by all members of the organization.

# CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

BARANGAY BANTAY ABOT SENIOR CITIZENS ORGANIZATION

# PREAMBLE

We, the senior citizens of Barangay Bantay Abot, invoking the benign aid of God in order to establish an organization that shall embody our ideals, cultivate our individual capabilities, promote our moral, socio and economic well-being, protect and uphold the senior citizens rights, do hereby promulgate and adopt this Constitution and By-Laws.

# ARTICLE I

## NAME AND DOMICILE

- SECTION 1 This organization shall be known as the Barangay Bantay Abot Senior Citizens Crganization hereinafter referred to as BBASCO.
- SECTION 2 This organization shall be domiciled at the Barangay Social Welfare Office of Barangay Bantay bot, Narvacan, Ilocos Sur.

The Barangay Social Welfare Office located at the Barangay Hall shall be the official residence of BBASCO.

## ARTICLE II

# DECLARATION OF OBJECTIVES

The organization commits itself to the pursuit of the following objectives:

- SECTION 1 To establish an organization that will represent the senior citizens of the barangay in collective negotiations beneficial to its members.
- SECTION 2 To act as extension arm of the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) in communicating and implementing the programs of the government for the promotion of the general welfare of all senior citizens.
- SECTION 3 To plam and implement activities that enhance the physical, moral, social and spiritual development of the members.
- SECTION 4 To uphold the protection of dignity, freedom, and protection against exploitation and abuse of elderly citizens.
- STOTION 5 To arose enthusiasm among members:to become model, potential leaders, and useful citizens in the community.
- SECTION 6 To instill to the members the spirit of voluntarism, cooperation and dignity.
- SECTION 7 To promote fellowship, understanding and goodwill.
