## RESOLUTION NO. 35 Series of 2015

## A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE WHOLE TOWN OF NARVACAN, ILOCOS SUR UNDER A STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO TYPHOON 'INENG'

**WHEREAS,** Typhoon 'INENG' left in its wake 1 person dead, and extensive damage to infrastructure and agriculture worth millions in this town;

**WHEREAS,** continuous torrential rains caused riverbanks to overflow, landslides at the upland barangays and destruction of roads and bridges;

**WHEREAS,** floodwaters practically engulfed the 34 Barangays of Narvacan reaching neck deep in the town proper and submerging houses up to roof level in the low lying areas;

WHEREAS, the NDRRMC (Narvacan Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council) as well as the BDRRMC (Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction Management Councils) with the help of the Philippine Army and Coast Guard had to work overtime to rescue residents along the riverbanks and low lying areas bringing them to the assigned evacuation centers;

**WHEREAS,** reports from the Narvacan Agricultue Office shows 10 hectares of totally damage silted/eroded ricelands including reports on drowned and missing animals;

**NOW THEREFORE,** the Sangguniang Bayan, in a Special Session duly assembled, and on motion duly seconded, **RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** to declare Narvancan, Ilocos Sur under a State of Calamity due to Typhoon 'INENG'.

**RESOLVED FURTHER,** that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to all concerned for their information and reference.
