RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MASA MASID EXPANDED UGNAYAN NG BARANGAY AT SIMBAHAN (UBAS) TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) ACTION PLAN

WHEREAS, Republic Act 9155, also known as the "Comprehensive Dangerous Act of 2002", protects the state and its individuals from possible harms brought about by the abuse of illegal drug substances;

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued policies on advocating peace and order, public safety, transparency, accountability and anti-illegal drug campaigns;

WHEREAS, the MASA-MASID program is a community based initiative that engage volunteers in the fight against criminality, corruption and illegal drugs and adopts a multi-sectoral and mass based approach to ensure an effective war against illegal drugs and illegal drug related crimes;

WHEREAS, the program seeks to address the long standing battle against criminality, corruption and illegal drugs thus engaging the fait-based organization and community volunteers through the "Ugnayan ng Barangay at Simbahan" (UBAS);

WHEREAS, part of the MASA-MASID program is the profiling and assessment of the drug surrenderers before they enroll in the Community Based Rehabilitation Program which includes the Anti-illegal Drug Summit that serves as venue for the conduct of the profiling and assessment of the drug personalities.







II. PROJECT RATIONALE AND OBJECTIVES

Republic Act 9165, also known as the "Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002", protects the state and its individuals from the possible harms brought about by the abuse of illegal drug substances. It also has provisions supporting the unrelenting campaign against trafficking and use of illegal drugs through and effective enforcement of anti-drug policies, programs and projects.

The Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) has issued policies on advocating peace and order, public safety, transparency and accountability, and anti-illegal drug campaigns. One of these is Memorandum Circular 2016-116 dated September 2, 2016 discussing the MASA MASID Program and its implementation.

The MASA-MASID Program is a community based initiative to engage volunteers in a fight against criminality, corruption and illegal drugs. It shall adopt a multi-sectoral and mass based approach to ensure an effective war against illegal drugs and illegal drug related crime.

The program seeks to address the long standing battle against criminality, corruption and illegal drug. The faith-based organization and community volunteers will be engaged through the Ugnayan ng Barangay at Simbahan (UBAS).

For its initial implementation, the MASA-MASID is designed to enhance the conduct of advocacy and education campaign and information gathering and reporting to reduce the supply and demand of illegal drugs and community based rehabilitation program to address the needs of the drug surrenderers.

Part of the MASAMASID Program is the profiling and assessment of the drug surrenderers before they enroll in the Community Based Rehabilitation Program. The Anti-Illegal Drug Summit will serve as a venue for the conduct of the profiling and assessment of the drug surrenderers.

III. **PROJECT DESCRIPTION** (Explain the project, including activities that will be undertaken)


The Anti-Illegal Drug Summit is an activity to facilitate implementation of LGU-Narvacan MASAMASID Program. The following activities will be conducted during the summit:

1. Orientation on MASAMASID Program

4. Assessment of Drug Surrenderers


