EXCERPTS FROM THE MINUTES OF THE 40TH REGULAR SESSION OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF NARVACAN, ILOCOS SUR HELD ON OCTOBER 19, 2020 AT THE MUNICIPAL SESSION HALL

RESOLUTION NO. 119

Series of 2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR LUIS "CHAVIT" C. SINGSON TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH ILOCOS TRAINING AND REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER (ITRMC) TO PERFORM COVID-19 (SARS-COV-2) TESTING BY RT-PCR TO THIS MUNICIPALITY'S CONSTITUENTS

WHEREAS, the Ilocos Training and Regional Medical Center (ITRMC) was designated by the Department of Health (DOH) as a Substantial Laboratory for emerging and re-emerging infectious diseases and through the DOH Health Facilities and Services Regulatory (HFSRB) Board was issued a license to operate a clinical laboratory for COVID-19 (SARS-COV-2) by RT-PCR;

WHEREAS, the Research Institute for Tropical Medicine (RITM) certified ITRMC's Molecular Laboratory capable of performing independent testing center for COVID-19 (SARS-CoV-2) by RT-PCR;

WHEREAS, factoring in the spread of the global Covid-19 pandemic, the technical services of ITRMC's Molecular Laboratory is urgently needed to perform testing on the Narvacan townfolks to contain the deadly virus;

WHEREAS, by virtue of a Memorandum of Agreement, LGU Narvacan undertakes to allow ITRMC to perform testing for COVID-19 (SARS-CoV-2) RT-PCR on Narvacaneans, and correspondingly, ITRMC agrees to perform the same;

WHEREAS, relatively, pursuant to Philhealth Circular No. 2020-0010, its revisions and issuances, it shall be ITRMC who shall be entitled to file claims and reimbursements from PhilHealth concerning all tests performed;

WHEREAS, both parties shall be bound by the terms and conditions set forth in the MOA;

NOW THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** unanimously, in session assembled, to authorize the Hon. Mayor Luis Chavit C. Singson to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with Ilocos Training and Regional Medical Center (ITRMC) to perform Covid-19 (Sars-Cov-2) testing by RT-PCR to this municipality's constituents.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish copies to all parties and government agencies concerned.
