RESOLUTION NO. 72

Series of 2020

RESOLUTION URGING THE LESSORS OF PRIVATE BUILDINGS TO WAIVE COMMERCIAL RENTS FOR THE ENTIRE PERIOD OF THE ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE FROM MARCH 15 TO APRIL 30, 2020 DUE TO COVID-19

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 922, Series of 2020, dated March 8, 2020 declared the entire country under a State of Public Health Emergency due to Covid-19;

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 929, Series of 2020, dated March 16, 2020 placed the entire country under a State of Calamity for a period of six (6) months;

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, the Honorable Ryan Luis V. Singson, Governor of the Province of Ilocos Sur, issued Executive Order No. 14, placing the entire province of Ilocos Sur under Enhanced Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, the town of Narvacan was under a State of Enhanced Community Quarantine prohibiting residents from going out of their homes, and suspending regular government transactions and operation of certain businesses due to the Covid-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, lessees of commercial spaces were also forced to suspend their operations during the period of the Enhanced Community Quarantine and are now under financial distress impairing their ability to comply with rental obligations;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Narvacan, Ilocos Sur, in its sincerest concern, wants to lessen the burden and mitigate the effects of the Covid-19 pandemic to those affected in the business sector;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** to urge the lessors of private buildings to waive commercial rents for the entire period of the Enhanced Community Quarantine from March 15 to April 30, 2020 due to Covid-19;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to all parties and persons concerned, for their information and appropriate actions.
