EXCERPTS FROM THE MINUTES OF THE 26TH REGULAR SESSION OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF NARVACAN, ILOCOS SUR HELD ON JULY 13, 2020 AT THE MUNICIPAL SESSION HALL

ORDINANCE NO. 35
 Series of 2020

ORDINANCE PROVIDING NEW MARKET OPERATION, REGULATING TALIPAPAS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF NARVACAN DURING THE IMPOSITION OF LOW-RISK MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN ILOCOS SUR, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2020, through Resolution No. 48, Series of 2020, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Infectious Diseases (IATF) approved the recalibration of the parameters for risk classification of provinces, highly urbanized cities and independent component cities effective July 1, 2020;

WHEREAS, under the new IATF classification, areas with high risk of corona virus infection are either placed under Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) or Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ). Moderate risk places are classified under General Community Quarantine (GCQ) or Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ). Low risk areas fall under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ);

WHEREAS, the Province of Ilocos Sur, along with other provinces, falls under Low-Risk Modified General Community Quarantine and the rest are placed under GCQ or MGCQ until July 15, 2020 unless earlier lifted or further extended;

WHEREAS, Low-Risk MGCQ is lower than the actual MGCQ; a more relaxed classification but all minimum health standards are still implemented in all settings;

WHEREAS, there is a need to build on the existing measures of the municipality relative to the Covid-19 outbreak and complement efforts to strengthen the implementation of said measures in order to protect the people of Narvacan from the contagion;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Narvacan, Ilocos Sur in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance shall be known as "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING NEW MARKET OPERATION, REGULATING TALIPAPAS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF NARVACAN DURING THE IMPOSITION OF LOW-RISK MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN ILOCOS SUR, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF"

SECTION 2. The Narvacan Public Market shall now be open without the weekly AM/PM schedule by Zone. The Narvacan Public Market shall be in operation from 5:00 AM to 8:00 PM. However, it shall be closed on Sundays for the implementation of major disinfection measures.

All business establishments shall designate floor or pavement markings within their premises of at least one (1) meter distance from one person to another to maintain the required social or physical distancing.

Business establishments providing services (restaurants, beauty parlors/salons, remittance centers, pawnshops, medical/dental clinics, optical shops, etc.) that take long for fifteen (15) minutes or more shall be required to have their own log book of customers. The logbook shall contain the date of entry, name, age, address, contact number, log in, and signature of the customers. They shall also be required to provide alcohol or alcohol-based sanitizer with 70-90% alcohol concentration.

SECTION 3. All those entering the Narvacan Public Market shall be required to follow the applicable guidelines and strictly maintain the minimum public health standards such as:

- 3.1. wearing of face mask/covering
- 3.2. maintain social/physical distancing

SECTION 4. There shall be three (3) entrances to the Narvacan Public Market: beside the Cozy Corner, beside Daybright, and the road north of the Balikbayan Hall. Monitoring staff shall be positioned at the entrances to control customer entry. Cues in the form of numbers (001-300) shall be given to customers upon entry. These numbers shall be surrendered to the monitoring staff upon exit. If the maximum number of customers is reached, the monitoring staff shall only allow one (1) person to get inside for every person that leaves.

Market-goers, before entry to the Public Market, shall present their Identification cards and shall undergo strict screening protocols such as:

- 4.1. logbook registration (for contact tracing in case somebody will test positive for Covid-19) .
- 4.2. thermal screening
- 4.3. sanitizing hands

SECTION 5. Operation of 'talipapas' or temporary wet market along the National Highway within the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Narvacan and all 'talipapas' close or near the public market shall be strictly prohibited. This is to bring back the vendors inside the public market and for security purposes. However, 'talipapas' long established before the Covid-19 like those four (4) in Lungog and one (1) in Quinarayan shall be exempted from this prohibition.

SECTION 6. PENALTIES. Any person caught violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be penalized.

6.1. Market vendors found violating SECTION 2 of this Ordinance shall be penalized with:

- First Offense - Php 1,500.00
- Second Offense - Php 2,000.00
- Third Offense - Php 2,500.00 and Suspension of business permit
- Fourth Offense - Revocation of business permit

6.2. Any person found violating SECTION 3 of this Ordinance shall be penalized in accordance with Ordinance No. 24, Series of 2020 Enacting the Narvacan Anti-Covid-19 (Novel Corona Virus) Ordinance, Consolidating All Anti-Corona Ordinances, Measures and Issuances, and for Other Purposes.

6.3 Any person found violating SECTIONS 4 and 5 of this Ordinance shall be meted with fines:

- First Offense - Php 1,500.00
- Second Offense - Php 2,000.00
- Third Offense - Php 2,500.00 or imprisonment of one (1) month or both at the discretion of the Court



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SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules or regulations in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. Upon urgent certification of the Mayor and motion unanimously approved suspending the rule on the 3-day reading of Ordinances, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon approval.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
